#### SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

#### DANGER

To reduce the risk of electric shock, burns, fire or injury:

- 1. Do not use while bathing or in a shower.
- 2. Do not place or store unit where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- 3. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- 4. Do not reach for unit that has fallen into water. Unplug it immediately.
- Care should be taken so that objects do not fall and liquids are not spilled onto the unit.

#### WARNING


- 1. Close supervision is necessary when this unit is used by or near children.
- 2. Use this unit only for its intended use as described in this manual.
- Unplug this unit during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.
- 4. Never drop or insert an object into any opening.
- 5. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched, particularly at plug outlets, convenience receptacles and the point where it exits the unit.
- Do not allow cord to touch hot surfaces. Wrap cord loosely around the unit when storing.
- 7. The unit should be situated away from direct sunlight or heat sources such as radiators, electric heaters, heat registers, stoves, or other units (including amplifiers) that produce heat. Avoid placing on top of stereo equipment that radiates heat.

- Never block the air openings of the unit with materials such as clothing, plastic bags or papers, or place it on a soft surface such as a bed or couch, where the air openings may be blocked.
- 9. Do not overload electrical outlet. Use only the power source as indicated.
- 10. Do not carry this unit by cord or use cord as handle.


- 1. CONTROL PANEL

- 4. POWER LEVEL BUTTON




#### **OPERATION**

- Open the lid and fill the STAINLESS STEEL TANK up to the MAX level with cool tap water.
- 2. Insert the power cord into an electrical outlet. The DISPLAY illuminates.
- Place items in the BASKET and place the BASKET in the STAINLESS STEEL TANK—ensuring that the water does not exceed the recommended MAX water level after the items are submerged.

Note: Lay your watch over the WATCH STAND (see Fig. 1). Or place 2 CDs or DVDs on the CD/DVD RACK and separate with the CD/DVD SEPARATOR RING (see Fig. 2).

- 4. Close the lid.
- Press TIMER BUTTON incrementally until the desired time appears on the DISPLAY: 090, 180, 280, 380 or 480 seconds.



Note: The amount of time you select should depend on the quantity and cleanliness of the pieces. It is advised to clean a CD or DVD with graphics only once in cool water for 90 seconds as there is a chance the graphics will fade.

Press the LEVEL BUTTON to select desired intensity. The intensity depends on the type of cleaning needed and the type of item being cleaned.

Example of intensities for different types of items:

- 3 HIGH Glasses and waterproof watches (up to 30 meters)
- 2 MEDIUM Jewelry
- 1 LOW CDs and DVDs
- Press START/STOP BUTTON to start the cleaning process. A blue light will illuminate and the time left for cleaning will count down on the DISPLAY.

Note: Press START/STOP BUTTON to interrupt or resume the cleaning cycle.

- When the chosen cycle is complete, the unit will automatically turn off and the blue light on the DISPLAY will turn off. If additional cleaning is necessary, repeat the steps above to repeat the cycle.
- 9. When you are done cleaning your items, unplug the unit and open lid to remove the items, pour water out of the tank and wipe dry with a soft, clean cloth.

#### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Wipe dry with a soft clean cloth and then store in a cool, dry place.
